



Hunting Rules and Conditions

1. Right of admission is reserved
2. No Hunting from vehicles
3. The camp fees/daily rate are payable in respect of the full period booked and for the number of persons booked for.
4. If a non-hunter is in the veld with a rifle, the hunters' tariff for the full duration of your stay is payable.
5. In the veld your guide must accompany you.
6. You may hunt from sunrise until sundown only. NO hunting at night.
7. No hunting near water holes or drinking troughs.
8. No hunting whatsoever for 1km radius around the camp or farm manager's house.
9. Do not litter or drop cigarette butts in the veld or around the camp.
10. Do not give alcohol to the staff.
11. No alcohol while you hunt. A hunter under the influence will not be permitted into the veld to hunt.
12. We have an arrangement with our guides that we will double all bribes offered.
13. Check in after 14h00 on the day of arrival and check out by 12h00 on the day for departure.
14. No caliber smaller than .243 or 6mm permitted.
15. All animals bagged, wounded or lost will be paid for
16. All firearms must be unloaded while in camp and while on vehicles. All weapons will be kept in the locked safe while in camp.
17. Any damage to property and any breakages will be added to the hunter' account.
18. All weapons will be "sighted in" on the shooting range under the supervision of the farm manager.
19. Only with the permission of the farm manager will you be permitted to hunt birds.
20. You are responsible for the species, size and sex of the game you shoot. You must not rely on the guide, as no discount is given for incorrect game.
21. All kitchen and butchery utensils, linen and towels stay in camp. Stock is taken prior to your stay and on your departure. The hunting party will pay for items missing.
